- 1.) Our Grade 7 class raised \$570 with their bake sale and float sale to support the earthquake victims in Turkey and Syria. The money was donated to Doctors without Borders.
- 2.) New lockers have been ordered and we hope to see them arrive in March so that they can be installed over the Easter holidays. More storage has been built in the art room and we are ready to move the sewing machines into the school so that they will be put to more use.
- 3.) The Alberta Ed Assurance surveys are being done by staff and students this week, and a highlight note and reminder have been sent to parents.
